Senate Bill 25 provides in part that no incumbent partisan state elective official may accept any contribution for the purpose of promoting that official's nomination or re-election to the office held by the official during the period beginning on the first Monday of January in each odd-numbered year and ending on the date of enactment of the Biennial Budget Act.

Senate Amendment 1 provides that the period during which an incumbent official may not accept a contribution will begin on January 1 of each odd-numbered year.

Legislative History

On February 28, 2008, the Senate Committee on Campaign Finance Reform, Rural Issues and Information Technology introduced and adopted Senate Amendment 1 and recommended passage of Senate Bill 25, as amended, both on votes of Ayes, 4; and Noes, 0.
