



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2007 Senate Bill 561**

**Senate Amendment 1**

*Senate Amendment 1* to the bill does the following:

1. The title to new s. 85.07 (9), created in the *bill*, is “CHILD SAFETY PROGRAM AND DATABASE.” Since the bill does not provide for the keeping of a database of information, the *amendment* deletes “AND DATABASE” from this title.
2. The *bill* requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to include, with each mailed notice of motor vehicle license renewal, “a one-page informational sheet” reminding licensees of the hazards to young children in potential off-highway accident situations. The *amendment* deletes “a one-page informational sheet” and substitutes “information.” This change permits DOT to establish the format of the information to be provided (e.g., a card or a slip of paper with the information on it).
3. The amendment makes a technical drafting change, deleting an unnecessary “and” on p. 3, line 18, of the bill.

### Legislative History

In executive session on March 5, 2008, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Tourism voted to introduce and adopt Senate Amendment 1 and to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
