

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2007 Senate Bill 72 creates the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Compact and Commission. It designates four members to the commission and specifies that the members shall serve without compensation, except that they shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. It also specifies that the Department of Transportation shall pay the cost of membership in the commission.

Senate Amendment 1 to 2007 Senate Bill 72 deletes the provision that provides for the reimbursement of the actual and necessary expenses incurred by members of the commission.

Legislative History

On November 30, 2007, the Senate Committee on Commerce, Utilities, and Rail voted to introduce Senate Amendment 1 to 2007 Senate Bill 72 and to recommend adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and passage of Senate Bill 72, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.

On December 11, 2007, the Senate adopted Senate Amendment 1 to 2007 Senate Bill 72 and passed Senate Bill 72, as amended, on voice votes.

On January 31, 2008, the Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended concurrence in 2007 Senate Bill 72 on a vote of Ayes, 11; Noes, 0.
