Assembly Bill 447 authorizes a school board to grant a vocational high school diploma to a pupil who earns the required credits for high school graduation under state law and as required by the school board and who successfully completes a vocational education program established by the school board.

Assembly Amendment 2 changes the phrases “vocational high school diploma” and “vocational education program” to “technical education high school diploma” and “technical education program.”

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 2 was offered by Representative Radcliffe on January 9, 2012. On January 18, 2012, the Assembly Committee on Education recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 2 on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 2.
