2011 Senate Bill 155

Senate Bill 155 allows a winery to sell wine in an original package or by the glass, and to provide taste samples of its wine, at a fairground under the fair association's temporary "Class B" retail license, if the wine is purchased from a wholesaler. The bill also permits a fair, that receives state aid, to allow the sale of wine on the fairground, without affecting the receipt of the state aid.

Senate Amendment 1

Senate Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 155 delays the effective date of the bill to the first day of the third month after publication.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Senate Bill 155 was introduced on July 19, 2011, by Senator Moulton; and others. On December 14, 2011, the Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Rural Issues introduced and adopted the amendment, both on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
