



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2011 Senate Bill 335**

*Senate Bill 335* authorizes a school board to grant a vocational high school diploma to a pupil who earns the required credits for high school graduation under state law and as required by the school board and who successfully completes a vocational education program established by the school board.

*Senate Amendment 2* uses the phrases “technical education high school diploma” and “technical education program” instead of “vocational high school diploma” and “vocational education program.”

### **Legislative History**

Senate Amendment 2 was offered by Senator Wanggaard. On January 11, 2012, the Senate Committee on Education voted unanimously to recommend adoption of Senate Amendment 2 and passage of the bill, as amended.
