



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2013 Assembly Bill 449**

**Assembly Amendment 1**

*Assembly Bill 449* provides that individuals engaged in certain sales activity are not covered under the unemployment insurance law. Specifically, the bill provides an exemption for an individual who is engaged, in a home or other than in a permanent retail establishment, in the service of selling or soliciting the sale of consumer products for use, sale, or resale by the buyer, if substantially all of the remuneration therefor is directly related to the sales or other output rather than to hours worked.

*Assembly Amendment 1* specifies that the “output” in the remuneration requirement must be “output related to sales.”

### **Bill History**

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by the Assembly Committee on Labor. On October 29, 2013, the committee recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 449, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
