2013 Senate Bill 365 relates to coverage of certain individuals engaged in sales activity outside a permanent retail establishment under the unemployment insurance law.

2013 Senate Bill 365

Senate Bill 365 revises the unemployment insurance exemption for individuals commonly referred to as “direct sellers.” The bill provides that such a person is exempt if the person is engaged in selling or soliciting the sale of consumer products while in a home or in another setting outside of a permanent retail establishment, and substantially all of the person’s pay for the work is directly related to the sales or other output.

Senate Amendment 1

Senate Amendment 1 specifies that the pay for “other output” must be related to the sales.

Bill History

On November 5, 2013, the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Labor adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
