2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 579

2015 Assembly Bill 579 exempts the naturally shed or lawfully taken feathers of a grouse, partridge, pheasant, quail, or wild turkey from the current general prohibitions against the sale, purchase, barter, or trade, of wild animals.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that the exemption under the bill only applies to naturally shed feathers of a grouse of a species not listed as endangered or threatened and not a sharp-tailed grouse.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Ed Brooks on January 14, 2016. On January 20, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 579, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0.
