**2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 785**

Assembly Bill 785 relates to certification of dementia specialists.

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2**

The substitute amendment creates a dementia specialist certification. Under the substitute amendment, a person who successfully completes an instructional program that provides the instruction specified in the substitute amendment must be certified as a dementia specialist by the instructional program administrator. No person may use the title “dementia specialist” or “certified dementia specialist” without the certification.

**BILL HISTORY**

Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 was introduced by Representative Rohrkaste on February 9, 2016. On February 18, 2016, the Assembly adopted Assembly Substitute Amendment 2, and the bill, as amended, on voice votes.
