2015 SENATE BILL 360

Senate Bill 360 makes changes to numerous administrative rules promulgated by the Department of Transportation (DOT) in the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 removes from the bill all changes to ch. Trans 400, Wis. Adm. Code, relating to the Wisconsin Environmental Policy Act procedures for DOT actions.

SENATE AMENDMENT 2

Senate Amendment 2 repeals a rule relating to warranty repair reimbursement for dealers that has been superseded by statute.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Petrowski offered Senate Amendment 1 on December 7, 2015, and Senate Amendment 2 on January 11, 2016. On January 14, 2016, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs voted unanimously to recommend adoption of Senate Amendments 1 and 2 and passage of Senate Bill 360, as amended.
