2015 SENATE BILL 596

Senate Bill 596 consolidates several appropriations for workforce training programs into a single appropriation to the Department of Workforce Development (DWD), to be used for workforce training grants.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 deletes a provision allowing DWD to use workforce training grant appropriations for career and technical education incentive grants to school districts.

SENATE AMENDMENT 2

Senate Amendment 2 requires DWD to include, in its annual report to the Governor and the Joint Committee on Finance, details of how it allocated and spent the funds appropriated to it for workforce training programs in that fiscal year.

BILL HISTORY

Senate Amendments 1 and 2 were offered by Senator Kapenga on January 28, 2016. On February 4, 2016, the Senate Committee on Workforce Development, Public Works, and Military Affairs recommended adoption of both amendments, on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0. The committee recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
