### **2017 SENATE BILL 414**

2017 Senate Bill 414 allows a minor to operate a temporary stand without a local permit or license and without a state food processing or retail food establishment license. To qualify, the stand must gross less than \$1,000 per year, be operated on a temporary, occasional basis on private property, for the sale of goods directly to consumers.

### **SENATE AMENDMENT 1**

Senate Amendment 1 to the bill removes the annual sales limitation and specifies that the stand will be treated as an “occasional sale” that is exempt from the state seller’s permit, regardless of the amount of sales.

### **BILL HISTORY**

Senate Amendment 1 was offered by Senator Johnson on October 10, 2017. On October 12, 2017, the Senate Committee on Labor and Regulatory Reform recommended adoption of the amendment, and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
