2021 Senate Bill 39

**Senate
Amendment 1**

2021 SENATE BILL 39

2021 Senate Bill 39 allows a virtual charter school student to participate in interscholastic athletics and extracurricular activities in the student's resident school district.

2021 Senate Bill 39 also prohibits a public school district from being a member of an interscholastic athletic association in the 2021-22 school year unless the association considers the method of educational programming during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 school years to be extenuating circumstances which justify a student transferring schools. The bill further prohibits association membership by a school district unless the educational programming-related transfer waiver granted by the association allows the student to compete at all levels, including varsity, during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 school years.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 eliminates the provision in the bill prohibiting interscholastic athletic association membership unless the association provides a waiver from its transfer rules for reasons of educational programming.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Stroebel offered Senate Amendment 1 on March 15, 2021. On March 16, 2021, the Senate adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a voice vote and passed the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 20; Noes, 12.
