2023 Assembly Bill 715

Assembly Amendment 1

2023 Assembly Bill 715

2023 Assembly Bill 715 includes several provisions related to financial institutions. As relevant to Assembly Amendment 1, the bill creates a crime that prohibits intentionally causing impairment or interruption of use, in whole or in part, of a financial institution's automated teller machine or customer bank communications terminal. A person who commits this crime is guilty of a Class H felony.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 modifies the crime created in the bill by prohibiting intentionally causing impairment or interruption of use, in whole or in part, of any automated teller machine or customer bank communications terminal, rather than requiring that it be of a financial institution.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Katsma introduced Assembly Amendment 1 on January 3, 2024. On January 10, 2024, the Assembly Committee on Financial Institutions voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 715, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0.
