2025 Senate Bill 279

Senate Amendment 1

2025 SENATE BILL 279

Senate Bill 279 directs the Department of Justice (DOJ) to award grants to law enforcement agencies for the acquisition of data-sharing platforms that meet certain criteria. The bill contains a nonstatutory provision that permits the Joint Committee on Finance, upon request by DOJ, to supplement an appropriation to DOJ by up to \$2 million in each fiscal year in the 2025-27 biennium to implement the grant program.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 removes the nonstatutory provision described above.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Wanggaard offered Senate Amendment 1 to 2025 Senate Bill 279 on June 13, 2025. On June 18, 2025, the Senate adopted the amendment on a voice vote. It then passed the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 17; Noes, 15.
