## **1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 27**

January 19, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives LADWIG, WALKER, HANDRICK, LAZICH, JENSEN, SCHNEIDERS, AINSWORTH, BRANCEL, DUFF, SKINDRUD, LEHMAN, KLUSMAN and SILBAUGH, cosponsored by Senators HUELSMAN, PETAK, A. LASEE and DARLING. Referred to Committee on Government Operations.

1 AN ACT to amend 301.08 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes; relating to: allowing the

2 department of corrections to enter into contracts with others to operate prisons

3 and granting rule–making authority.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of corrections (DOC) may purchase care or services as an alternative to DOC providing the care or services itself. DOC also has specific authority to contract with a public, private or voluntary agency to operate a minimum security state prison. This bill authorizes DOC to enter into a contract with a public, private or voluntary agency to operate any state prison. The contract must include a requirement that the costs to the state be reduced by at least 10% as adjusted for inflation.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 301.08 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
