



## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 33

January 19, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives BALDUS, HARSDORF, MEYER, MUSSER, BALDWIN, HAHN, BAUMGART, BELL, BLACK, BOYLE, GROBSCHMIDT, GRONEMUS, HASENOHRL, HUBER, KREUSER, MORRIS-TATUM, NOTESTEIN, PLOMBON, RYBA, SPRINGER, WILDER, L. YOUNG, R. YOUNG, ZIEGELBAUER and BRANDEMUEHL, cosponsored by Senators DRZEWIECKI, RISSER, WINEKE, ANDREA, CHVALA, CLAUSING, DECKER and MOEN. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 36.27 (1) (a); and **to create** 36.27 (1) (b) of the statutes;  
2             **relating to:** tuition for undergraduates at the University of Wisconsin System  
3             and granting rule-making authority.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill directs the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System, beginning in the 1996-97 academic year, to establish academic fees for resident undergraduates at a level not to exceed 33% of instructional costs and tuition for nonresident undergraduates at a level not to exceed 120% of instructional costs.

### *The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 36.27 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5             36.27 (1) (a) Subject to ~~par.~~ pars. (b) and (c), the board may establish for  
6             different classes of students differing tuition and fees incidental to enrollment in  
7             educational programs or use of facilities in the system. Except as otherwise provided  
8             in this section, the board may charge any student who is not exempted by this section  
9             a nonresident tuition. The board may establish special rates of tuition and fees for  
10            the extension and summer sessions and such other studies or courses of instruction  
11            as the board deems advisable.
