1995 SENATE BILL 129

April 5, 1995 – Introduced by Senators Petak, Andrea and Panzer, cosponsored by Representatives Ladwig, Turner, Porter, Plache and Kreuser. Referred to Committee on Environment and Energy.

AN ACT *to affect* 1983 Wisconsin Act 162, section 1 (2) (c); **relating to:** certain submerged lands conveyed to the city of Racine for park, recreational and public facilities.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under 1983 Wisconsin Act 162, the state conveyed to the city of Racine a submerged parcel of land on the bed of Lake Michigan. That act authorized the construction of public park facilities, marinas, docks, roads and other structures on the parcel of land. The act also authorized the construction and operation of a restaurant on the parcel for improving the recreational quality of the marina for the general public. This bill authorizes the construction and operation of a swimming pool for the same purpose.

Because this bill concerns a conveyance of a lake bed area, the department of natural resources, as required by law, will prepare a detailed report to be printed as an appendix to this bill.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 1983 Wisconsin Act 162, section 1 (2) (c) is created to read:

[1983 Wisconsin Act 162] Section 1 (2) (c) On the lands described under Section 2 of this act, the city of Racine may construct and operate or permit the construction and operation of a swimming pool designed to enhance the use of the marina facilities
