- July 12, 1995 Introduced by Senators FARROW, ROSENZWEIG, HUELSMAN, DARLING, COWLES and ZIEN, cosponsored by Representatives WALKER, DUFF, URBAN, SCHNEIDERS, OWENS, LADWIG, HAHN, GUNDERSON, SERATTI, KELSO, LORGE, GROTHMAN, OLSEN and LAZICH. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Agriculture and Local Affairs.
- 1 AN ACT to renumber 114.31 (3); and to create 114.31 (3) (b) of the statutes;

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT), in cooperation with the appropriate educational institutions, formulates and promotes programs of aviation education and training. This bill prohibits DOT from administering, funding or promoting an education or training course that is a refresher course for flight instruction.

3 SECTION 1. 114.31 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 114.31 (3) (a).
4 SECTION 2. 114.31 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

- 5 114.31 (3) (b) Notwithstanding par. (a), the department may not administer,
- 6 fund or promote any education or training course that is a refresher course for flight
- 7 instruction.
