- 1 AN ACT to amend chapter 213 (title); and to create 213.105 of the statutes;
- 2 **relating to:** designation of a state fire fighters memorial.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill designates the city of Wisconsin Rapids as the official site of the State Fire Fighters Memorial to honor all fire fighters of this state who have given their lives in the public service. Currently, there is no official site for such a memorial.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **Section 1.** Chapter 213 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 CHAPTER 213
5 FIRE FIGHTERS'
6 ASSOCIATIONS FIGHTING

Section 2. 213.105 of the statutes is created to read:

213.105 State Fire Fighters Memorial. The State Fire Fighters Memorial, located in the city of Wisconsin Rapids, is designated the official memorial to honor all fire fighters of this state who have given their lives in the public service.
