



1995 SENATE BILL 562

February 21, 1996 - Introduced by Senator WEEDEN, cosponsored by Representative BRANCEL, by request of Governor Tommy G. Thompson. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** reimbursement by the public defender board to private
2 attorneys and private investigators and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The bill increases, for fiscal year 1995-96 and fiscal year 1996-97, the appropriation to the state public defender board for payment to private attorneys and private investigators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.**

4 (1) PRIVATE BAR AND INVESTIGATOR REIMBURSEMENT. In the schedule under section
5 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the public defender board under
6 section 20.550 (1) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount
7 is increased by \$684,000 for fiscal year 1995-96 and the dollar amount is increased
8 by \$1,546,500 for fiscal year 1996-97 to increase funding for the purposes for which
9 the appropriation is made.
