



1995 SENATE BILL 641

March 21, 1996 - Introduced by Senators RISSER, WINEKE and BURKE, cosponsored by Representatives NOTESTEIN, BALDWIN, R. YOUNG, BLACK, L. YOUNG, BOYLE and WASSERMAN. Referred to Committee on Education and Financial Institutions.

1 **AN ACT to create** 115.28 (40) of the statutes; **relating to:** the development and
2 distribution to pupils of a pamphlet that provides information about acquired
3 immunodeficiency syndrome.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the department of education to develop and annually distribute to each school board and to each private school participating in the Milwaukee parental choice program pamphlets appropriate to each grade level that provide information about the human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome. The school board must distribute the pamphlets to all pupils enrolled in the school district and the private school must distribute the pamphlets to all pupils enrolled in the private school.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 115.28 (40) of the statutes is created to read:
5 115.28 (40) ACQUIRED IMMUNODEFICIENCY SYNDROME INFORMATION. Develop and
6 annually distribute to each school board, and to each private school participating in
7 the program under s. 119.23, pamphlets appropriate to each grade level that provide
8 information about the human immunodeficiency virus and acquired

1 immunodeficiency syndrome, including information about preventing the spread of
2 the virus. The school board shall distribute the pamphlets to all pupils enrolled in
3 the school district, including pupils enrolled in charter schools located in the school
4 district, and the governing body of the private school shall distribute the pamphlets
5 to all pupils enrolled in the private school.
