

## **1995 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 55**

March 14, 1996 – Introduced by Senators CHVALA, CLAUSING, BURKE and GROBSCHMIDT, cosponsored by Representatives HANSON, BALDWIN and BOCK. Referred to Committee on State Government Operations and Corrections.

1	Relating to: encouraging employers to facilitate the participation of their employes
2	as elections inspectors.
3	Whereas, participation in the electoral process is a right and a privilege of all
4	Americans; and
5	Whereas, free elections are the foundation of our American democracy; and
6	Whereas, citizens of the United States are encouraged to actively participate
7	in the electoral process as a means of exercising the principles of democracy; and
8	Whereas, citizens are encouraged to participate through voting and serving as
9	elections inspectors; and
10	Whereas, elections inspectors act so as to promote and maintain order at polling
11	sites; and
12	Whereas, elections inspectors promote fair and legitimate polling of electors;
13	and
14	Whereas, a citizen should be encouraged to participate in the electoral process,
15	such as by serving as an elections inspector; now, therefore, be it
16	Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the
17	Wisconsin legislature, in accordance with Wisconsin statute 7.33 (3), encourage

- 1 employers in the state of Wisconsin to promote the participation of employes in the
- 2 electoral process through their service as elections inspectors.
