March 21, 1996 – Introduced by Senator C. Potter, cosponsored by Representative Ziegelbauer. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	Relating to: proclaiming National Garden Week in Wisconsin.
2	Whereas, gardening is an illustration of respect and care for our environment
3	and natural resources; and
4	Whereas, the gardeners and growers of the state of Wisconsin produce fruits
5	and vegetables that provide nutritional sustenance for our citizens; and
6	Whereas, these gardeners work diligently to beautify our communities by the
7	propagation of trees, flowers and ornamentals; and
8	Whereas, our gardeners help to preserve our American traditions in an
9	expression of independence, creativity and initiative; now, therefore, be it
10	Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the
11	legislature of the state of Wisconsin proclaim June 2 to June 8, 1996, as "National
12	Garden Week in Wisconsin".
