March 27, 1996 – Introduced by Senators Schultz, Welch, Darling, Drzewiecki, Panzer, Fitzgerald, Zien, Huelsman, Weeden, Petak, Farrow, Breske, Rude, Buettner, Cowles, Jauch, Shibilski, Wineke, C. Potter, Andrea and Grobschmidt. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

**Relating to:** expressing support for the Republic of China (Taiwan).

Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) has had a special relationship with

the people and state of Wisconsin for many years; and

Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is a paradigm of the success of a market-based economic system and a democratic political system; and

Whereas, in recent weeks, the People's Republic of China has been escalating its threatening rhetoric and propaganda directed at the Republic of China (Taiwan); and

Whereas, the people of Wisconsin are concerned with the security of the citizens and government of the Republic of China (Taiwan) and are supportive of its efforts to become a fully democratic nation; and

Whereas, it is the fervent hope and desire of the state of Wisconsin that the People's Republic of China will not interfere with the Republic of China's (Taiwan), continuing pursuit of a democratic political system, recognizing that the Republic of China (Taiwan) has successfully completed its first presidential election; now, therefore, be it
