1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 101

February 18, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives KREIBICH, NASS, SERATTI, SCHAFER, SYKORA, LA FAVE, ZUKOWSKI, HUEBSCH, KLUSMAN, GUNDERSON, HAHN, HANDRICK, AINSWORTH, FREESE, M. 1 AN ACT to renumber and amend 13.92 (1) (b) 1.; and to create 13.92 (1) (b) 1. 2 a. to c. of the statutes; relating to: persons authorized to submit drafting 3 requests to the legislative reference bureau.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill places in the statutes that part of joint rule 51 of the legislature which authorizes certain persons to submit drafting requests to the legislative reference bureau (LRB), but removes LRB drafting privileges from those agencies of Wisconsin state government which are not created in certain chapters of the statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6	the operation of the legislature.
