1 AN ACT to amend 15.405 (6) of the statutes; relating to: adding a 2nd dental

hygienist to the membership of dentistry examining board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the dentistry examining board (board) issues licenses to practice dentistry and dental hygiene. The board consists of 5 dentists, one dental hygienist and 2 members of the public. This bill adds a 2nd dental hygienist member to the board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 15.405 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 15.405 (6) DENTISTRY EXAMINING BOARD. There is created a dentistry examining

5 board in the department of regulation and licensing. The dentistry examining board

- 6 shall consist of 8 <u>9</u> members appointed for staggered 4-year terms. Five of the
- 7 members shall be licensed dentists in this state. One member <u>Two members</u> shall

be a dental hygienist hygienists licensed to practice in this state. Notwithstanding
s. 15.08 (1m) (a), the dental hygienist member members may participate in the
preparation and grading of licensing examinations for dental hygienists. Two
members shall be public members.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

6 (1) Notwithstanding the length of the terms specified in section 15.405 (6) of
7 the statutes, as affected by this act, one dental hygienist member of the dentistry
8 examining board shall be appointed by the first day of the 4th month beginning after
9 the effective date of this subsection for a term expiring on July 1, 2002.
