AN ACT to amend 15.94 (4) of the statutes; relating to: the term of the student 1 2

member of the state technical college board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, one member of the technical college system board must be a student enrolled at least half-time and in good academic standing at a technical college who is at least 18 years old and a resident of this state. The student member is appointed for a 2-year term.

This bill provides that the student member does not cease to be a member of the board if he or she graduates during his or her term.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.94 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.94 (4) One student enrolled at least half-time and in good academic standing at a technical college who is at least 18 years old and a resident of this state, for a 2-year term. The governor may not appoint a student member from the same technical college in any 2 consecutive terms. If the student member loses the status
