## **1997 SENATE BILL 136**

March 26, 1997 – Introduced by Senators Shibilski, Decker, Jauch, Burke, Wirch, George, Grobschmidt, C. Potter, Clausing, Breske, Moore, Risser, Plache, Chvala, Wineke, Schultz, Rude, Moen, Welch, A. 1 AN ACT to create 29.226 (4) of the statutes; relating to: hunting approvals

issued to persons born on or after January 1, 1973.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person born on or after January 1, 1973, may not be issued any type of approval authorizing hunting unless the person has successfully completed the hunter education and firearm safety course established by the department of natural resources (DNR). A person who has completed a similar program in another state or basic training in the U.S. armed forces is exempt from this requirement.

This bill allows a person who is required to have successfully completed the DNR course to show that he or she did so by presenting a hunting approval that he or she was issued in this state within the last year instead of showing the certificate of completion of the DNR course.

- **SECTION 1.** 29.226 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
