## 1997 SENATE BILL 387

December 30, 1997 - Introduced by Senators Ellis and Rosenzweig. Referred to Committee on Health, Human Services, Aging, Corrections, Veterans and Military Affairs.

An AcT relating to: the family practice residency program of the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., and making an appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides state funding to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., for the development and operation of a family practice residency program. This bill provides $\$ 181,900$ in fiscal year 1998-99 to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., to fund 2 additional family practice physicians for the residency program. These physicians must be allocated to maximize the number of residents in the family practice residency program.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. Nonstatutory provisions; Medical College of Wisconsin.

(1) Of the moneys appropriated to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., under section 20.250 (1) (b) of the statutes, $\$ 181,900$ in fiscal year 1998-99 may be expended only to fund 2 additional family practice physicians for the family practice residency
program. The 2 family practice physicians shall be allocated to maximize the number of family practice residents in the program.

## Section 2. Appropriation changes; Medical College of Wisconsin.

(1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., under section 20.250 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1997 , the dollar amount is increased by $\$ 181,900$ for fiscal year 1998-99 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
