

## 1997 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 29

July 22, 1997 – Introduced by Senator Jauch, cosponsored by Representative Boyle. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Arthur Lenroot.
2	Whereas, Arthur Lenroot was born on February 18, 1912, in Superior, and died
3	on July 8, 1997, in Santa Rosa, California; and
4	Whereas, he was educated in the Superior public schools, at Superior State
5	College and the College of St. Thomas; and
6	Whereas, he worked for a railroad and an oil company and was a traveling
7	salesman and a title abstractor; and
8	Whereas, Mr. Lenroot was elected to the assembly in 1942 and 1944 and to the
9	senate in 1946, 1948, 1950 and 1952; and
10	Whereas, he served as a chairperson of the Joint Committee on Finance; and
11	Whereas, he was active in conservation and in tourism promotion, serving as
12	president of the Douglas County Fish and Game League, as chairperson of the
13	Douglas County Conservation Congress and as director of the Douglas County
14	division of the Indianhead Association; and
15	Whereas, he was also Douglas County abstractor and a member of the national
16	guard; and

Whereas, after leaving the legislature, Mr. Lenroot was the state director of the 1 2 Mortgage Guarantee Insurance Corporation; now, therefore, be it 3 Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the Wisconsin legislature commend Arthur Lenroot's many years of public service, 4 5 express their sorrow at his death and extend their condolences to his family and 6 friends; and, be it further 7 **Resolved, That** the senate chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint 8 resolution to Mr. Lenroot's wife, Ellie, and to his 3 children. 9 (END)
