



1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 408

July 8, 1999 - Introduced by Representative MORRIS-TATUM. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 134.77 (4); and *to create* 125.12 (2) (ag) 8., 125.12 (4) (ag) 9.
2 and 134.77 (3m) of the statutes; **relating to:** the volume of malt liquor
3 containers and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale and offering for sale in this state of containers of malt liquor that contain more than a quart of that beverage. A person who violates that prohibition is liable for a forfeiture of not more than \$500 for a first offense, for a forfeiture of not more than \$1,000 for a second offense and may have his or her license to sell alcohol beverages revoked or suspended for a third offense.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 125.12 (2) (ag) 8. of the statutes is created to read:
5 125.12 (2) (ag) 8. The person has been convicted 3 or more times for violations
6 of s. 134.77 (3m) or a local ordinance in conformity with that subsection.

7 **SECTION 2.** 125.12 (4) (ag) 9. of the statutes is created to read:
