1999 SENATE BILL 215

August 5, 1999 – Introduced by Senator Plache, cosponsored by Representatives Miller, Riley, Lassa and Young. Referred to Committee on Health, Utilities, Veterans and Military Affairs.

AN ACT *to create* 196.637 of the statutes; **relating to:** deferred payment agreements between public utilities and customers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, if a public utility and a customer make a deferred payment agreement regarding a delinquent account, the public utility may not report the delinquency to a credit reporting agency unless the customer fails to comply with the agreement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 196.637 of the statutes is created to read:

196.637 Deferred payment agreements. If a public utility and a customer enter into a deferred payment agreement regarding a delinquent account, the public utility may not report the delinquency to a credit reporting agency unless the customer fails to comply with agreement.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
