

## **2001 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 12**

February 19, 2001 – Introduced by Representatives CARPENTER, LA FAVE, STASKUNAS, MORRIS-TATUM, J. LEHMAN, BERCEAU and WILLIAMS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	<i>To renumber</i> assembly rule 28 and assembly rule 90; <i>to amend</i> assembly rule 28
2	(title); and <i>to create</i> assembly rule 28 (2) and assembly rule 90 (2); <b>relating</b>
3	to: the ending time of the daily sessions of the assembly.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution provides that the assembly sessions will end no later than midnight. However, the resolution permits a majority of the members to suspend the rule to complete the consideration of the proposal that is being considered at midnight. Otherwise, the assembly is prohibited from being in session between midnight and 7 a.m.

5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Assembly rule 28 (title) is amended to read:
6	Assembly Rule 28 (title) Hour for Daily sessions; convening,
7	adjournment.
8	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Assembly rule 28 is renumbered assembly rule $28(1)$ .
9	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Assembly rule 28 (2) is created to read:

1	Assembly Rule $28(2)$ The daily session of the assembly ends at midnight unless
2	adjourned earlier. The assembly may not conduct business during the hours between
3	midnight and 7 a.m., except as provided under rule 90 (2).
4	<b>SECTION 4.</b> Assembly rule 90 is renumbered assembly rule 90 $(1)$ .
5	<b>SECTION 5.</b> Assembly rule 90 (2) is created to read:
6	Assembly Rule 90 (2) Rule 28 (2) may be suspended by a majority of the
7	members present and voting, but the suspension under this subsection only applies
8	to the completion of the consideration of the proposal that is being considered at
9	midnight.
