2001 SENATE BILL 190

May 23, 2001 – Introduced by Senators BRESKE, WELCH, S. FITZGERALD, GEORGE, SCHULTZ and A. LASEE, cosponsored by Representatives WADE, KRAWCZYK, OWENS, SKINDRUD, VRAKAS, BIES and MCCORMICK. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT to repeal 118.045 (3); and to amend 118.045 (1) of the statutes; relating

to: the commencement of the school term.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits a school district from beginning the school term until September 1 unless the school board holds a public hearing on the issue and adopts a resolution to that effect. This bill eliminates this exception.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.045 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
118.045 (1) Except as provided in subs. <u>sub.</u> (2) and (3), beginning in the year
2000, no public school may commence the school term until September 1.
SECTION 2. 118.045 (3) of the statutes is repealed.
SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
