Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) provides state aid payments to local public bodies under the urban mass transit operating assistance program. Recipients of such aid payments are required to repay DOT for any overpayments under the program. This bill requires DOT to waive repayment by the city of Rhinelander for any overpayment of aid for calendar years 1997 through 1999.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Overpayment of state transit operating aids. Notwithstanding section 85.20 (4m) (er) of the statutes, the department of transportation shall waive repayment by the city of Rhinelander of any outstanding balance of overpayments
