## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 150

March 13, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Ziegelbauer, Van Akkeren, Plouff, Gunderson, Hahn, Kerkman and Kreibich, cosponsored by Senators Roessler and Stepp. Referred to Committee on Government Operations and Spending Limitations.

- AN ACT relating to: salary reductions for state senators and representatives to
- 2 the assembly during the 2005–2006 legislature.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that the annual salary of each representative to the assembly and each state senator whose term of office begins on January 3, 2005, shall be paid an annual salary of \$44,233 during the 2005–2006 legislature. Currently, during the 2003–2004 legislature, each representative to the assembly and each state senator whose term of office begins on January 6, 2003, is paid an annual salary of \$45,569.

committee on employment relations relating to establishing the annual salary of
each state senator and each representative to the assembly, the annual salary of each
state senator and representative to the assembly during the 2005-2006 legislature
shall be reduced to \$44,233.

(b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to the annual salary of any state senator that, under article IV, section 26, of the constitution, may not be reduced during the 2005–2006 legislature.
