1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Lawrence W. Timmerman.

2 Whereas, Lawrence W. Timmerman was born on June 1, 1910, in Milwaukee,
3 Wisconsin, and died on January 8, 2003; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Timmerman was educated in the Milwaukee parochial grade
5 schools and Marquette University High School; and

6 Whereas, he earned a bachelor's degree, a master's degree in political science,
7 and, subsequently, an LL.B degree from Marquette University; and

8 Whereas, he married Regina Disher in 1957, who preceded him in death in June
9 of 2002; and

10 Whereas, following in the footsteps of his father who served in the 1923
11 Wisconsin assembly and on the Milwaukee County Board, Mr. Timmerman was first
12 elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1954, representing Milwaukee-6th, and served
13 in the 1955 session, 1957 session, and part of the 1959 session before resigning to
14 accept an appointment to the Milwaukee County Board to fill the vacancy caused by
15 the death of his father; and
