2003 SENATE BILL 342

December 10, 2003 – Introduced by Senator Hansen, cosponsored by Representatives TURNER, OTT, ALBERS, KREIBICH, HINES, J. LEHMAN and SERATTI. Referred to Committee on Education, Ethics and Elections.

AN ACT to create 36.09 (2) (c) and 36.09 (3) (c) of the statutes; relating to: requiring the president and chancellors of the University of Wisconsin System to obtain Ethics Board approval before accepting corporate board compensation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the president and chancellors (including deans of the two-year college campuses) of the University of Wisconsin System to obtain the approval of the Ethics Board before accepting compensation for serving on a corporation's board of directors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5	SECTION 1. 36.09 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

36.09 (3) (c) Each chancellor and each dean of a college campus shall obtain the
approval of the ethics board before accepting compensation for serving on a
corporation's board of directors.
