## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a town board may meet in the town, or in any city, village, or town within or adjoining the town, subject to the open meetings law. Similarly, an annual or special town meeting may be held in the town or in any city or village within or adjoining the town. Under this bill, a town board may meet and an annual or special town meeting may be held in the town or in any other city, village, or town, subject to the open meetings law.

Under current law, when a town is divided into wards, the annual town meeting and special town elections must be held at the first ward. Under this bill, the annual town meeting and special town election must be held at the town hall.
