## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 604

August 16, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives Schneider, Sheridan and Fields. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

AN ACT to create 16.40 (24) and 20.505 (1) (fe) of the statutes; relating to: a grant for construction of the State Fire Fighters Memorial and making an appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the State Fire Fighters Memorial, located in the city of Wisconsin Rapids, is the official memorial to honor all fire fighters of this state who have given their lives in the public service. Under current law, the memorial receives no state funding.

This bill appropriates $\$ 350,000$ in general purpose revenue to provide a grant to the Wisconsin State Fire Fighters Memorial, Inc., for construction of the memorial.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 16.40 (24) of the statutes is created to read:
16.40 (24) State fire fighters memorial. From the appropriation under s. 20.505 (1) (fe), provide a grant to the Wisconsin State Fire Fighters Memorial, Inc., to be used for the construction of the State Fire Fighters Memorial under s. 213.105.

SECTION 2. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:
