- 5 <u>1, 2006, the circuit has 2 branches.</u>

#### Section 2. Nonstatutory provisions; circuit courts.

- 7 (1) The initial election for circuit judge for branch 2 of the circuit court for
- 8 Juneau County shall be at the spring election of 2006 for terms commencing August
- 9 1, 2006, and ending July 31, 2012.
