# **2005 SENATE BILL 203**

May 10, 2005 – Introduced by Senators Grothman, Olsen, Roessler, Leibham, Darling, Kanavas, Kedzie, A. Lasee and Lazich, cosponsored by Representatives Van Roy, LeMahieu, Gundrum, Kestell, Towns, Kerkman, Hahn, Strachota, Owens, Gunderson, Townsend, Kreibich, Musser, Hines, Lothian, Albers, Pridemore, J. Fitzgerald, Krawczyk, Vrakas, Pettis and Petrowski. Referred to Committee on Job Creation, Economic Development and Consumer Affairs.

- AN ACT to amend 77.52 (2) (a) 6. of the statutes; relating to: expanding the sales tax exemption for coin-operated laundry services to include all self-service
- 3 laundry services.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, laundry services performed by a customer in a coin-operated, self-service machine are exempt from the sales tax. This bill extends that exemption to all self-service laundry services.
