SENATE RULE 25 (3) Meetings of committees end at midnight unless adjourned earlier. Committees may not meet or conduct business during the hours between midnight and 8 a.m. Senate members of committees or other bodies may not be present at or participate in a meeting of or participate in the conduct of business by the committee or other body during the hours between midnight and 8 a.m.
