



2007 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 109

February 28, 2008 - Introduced by Representative MUSSER, cosponsored by Senator SULLIVAN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** recognizing the efforts of the Transition Assistance Advisor Program
2 in Wisconsin.

3 Whereas, following the attacks of September 11, 2001, more than 11,550
4 military personnel have been called to active duty by the Wisconsin National Guard
5 and Reserves to provide security at home and combat terrorism abroad; and

6 Whereas, the National Guard Bureau created the Transition Assistance
7 Advisor Program, which has been authorized by the Wisconsin National Guard to
8 serve Wisconsin military personnel and their families as a statewide point of contact
9 in accessing veterans benefits, programs, and services; and

10 Whereas, the transition assistance advisor has developed a strong state
11 coalition of community partnerships with county and tribal veterans service offices
12 across the state as well as with the Department of Defense, the Department of Labor,
13 the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Employer Support for the Guard and
14 Reserve, and veterans service organizations; and
