2007 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 66

September 20, 2007 - Introduced by Representatives Nelson and Montgomery, cosponsored by Senators Cowles and Hansen. Referred to Committee on Rules.

Relating to: the life and public service of Norbert DeCleene.

Whereas, Nubs initiated and organized the building of the Brown County
Veterans Memorial Monument, one of his proudest accomplishments as an elected
official; and
Whereas, Nubs leaves behind a lasting legacy and commitment to public
service, devotion to God and family, and love of country; now, therefore, be it

Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Norbert "Nubs"
DeCleene contributed to this state and his community, express their sorrow at his
passing, and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further

resolution to Nubs's wife, Nancy, and his 2 children, Somer and Chase.
