7	under 10 chief clerks and 11 speakers, and knew many people at the Capitol; and
8	Whereas, Jody's roots began in Madison, Wisconsin, whereby she was one of 11
9	children; and
10	Whereas, Jody married Dennis Nussbaum in April 1975 and had two children,
11	Sara and Megan, and two grandchildren, Brett and Cole; and
12	Whereas, Jody was actively involved in Girl Scouts for many years, participated
13	in Big Brothers Big Sisters of Dane County taking the role as a Big Sister, and is
14	known to some as a skillful seamstress; and
15	Whereas, it is expected that retirement will afford Jody more time to be with
16	her family and grandchildren; now, therefore be it further
17	Resolved by the assembly, That the members of the Wisconsin assembly,
18	express sincere thanks to Jody Nussbaum for her years of service in the assembly
19	chief clerk's office and wish her well in her new chapter of life; and, be it further
