



2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 903

March 26, 2010 - Introduced by Representatives ROYS, BERCEAU, HEBL, HILGENBERG, PASCH, A. WILLIAMS and RIPP, cosponsored by Senators ERPENBACH and LASSA. Referred to Committee on Consumer Protection.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 167.21 of the statutes; **relating to:** safety standards for
2 movable soccer goals, granting rule-making authority, and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Commerce (department) to promulgate rules that establish safety standards for erecting movable soccer goals. The bill prohibits a person from erecting a movable soccer goal unless the person erects the goal in a manner that is consistent with the rules promulgated by the department.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 167.21 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **167.21 Movable soccer goals. (1)** In this section:
5 (a) "Commission" means the federal consumer product safety commission.
6 (b) "Department" means the department of commerce.
7 (c) "Movable soccer goal" means a freestanding structure that consists of at
8 least 2 upright posts, a crossbar, and support bars and that is designed to be used as
9 a soccer goal and to be movable to different locations.
