



2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 920

April 2, 2010 – Introduced by Representative JORGENSEN. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 85.022 (2) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring the
2 Department of Transportation to study the feasibility of a passenger rail stop
3 in the city of Waterloo.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Transportation to study the feasibility of including a stop in the city of Waterloo in connection with a passenger rail route between the cities of Milwaukee and Madison.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 85.022 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
5 85.022 (2) (c) The department shall study the feasibility of including a stop in
6 the city of Waterloo in Jefferson County in connection with a passenger rail route
7 between the cities of Milwaukee and Madison.
